*Follow Jesus' footsteps each day of Holy Week as he journeyed toward the cross. Each day imagine you were present with Jesus in these events. What details stand out to you? What do you learn about Jesus? Which characters do you relate to? What emotions arise as you enter into what Jesus experienced?*

### Friday

- Betrayal and arrest ([Matt. 26:47-56](#); [Mark 14:43-52](#))
- Jewish Trial—Jesus appears in three phases in front of:
  - Annas ([John 18:13-24](#))
  - Caiaphas and partial Sanhedrin ([Matt. 26:57-75](#); [Mark 14:53-65](#))
  - Sanhedrin fully assembled (*perhaps after sunrise*) ([Matt. 27:1-2](#); [Mark 15:1](#))
- Roman trial—Jesus appears in three phases before:
  - Pilate ([Matt. 27:2-14](#); [Mark 15:2-5](#))
  - Herod Antipas ([Luke 23:6-12](#))
  - Pilate ([Matt. 27:15-26](#); [Mark 15:6-15](#))
- Crucifixion (*approx. 9:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M.*) ([Matt. 27:27-66](#); [Mark 15:16-39](#))
